



Guidelines for the 2019 ACS BIOT Young Investigator Award

-- Sponsored by Genentech, a Member of the Roche Group --

Deadline: August 1st, 2018

Purpose:

The Division of Biochemical Technology Young Investigator Award is intended to recognize an outstanding young contributor to the field of biochemical technology and active participant in the division programs. The award nominations will be judged according to criteria as set forth in this document. However, the criteria may change for future conferences, as appropriate.

Award:

At the ACS annual meeting for which BIOT chooses to program, an award of \$3000, to cover Honorarium and travel expenses to attend an annual meeting of the Biochemical Technology Division of the American Chemical Society and a commemorative plaque. The award ceremony takes place at an annual meeting and includes a presentation by the recipient on his/her research.

Eligibility:

The Division of Biochemical Technology Young Investigator Award is open to all researchers whom are 40 years old or younger on January 1st of the award year, both academic and industrial. It is expected that the award recipient will register, attend the conference, and present an award lecture.

Evaluation:

Nomination packages will be evaluated by a committee established by Awards Chair for the Division of Biochemical Technology in the American Chemical Society. The committee will consist of a combination of distinguished academic and industrial members of this field. The chair of the committee can not be a member of Genentech, Inc.

Criteria:

The nominations will be judged on the originality and overall quality of work, significance to the advancement of the field of biochemical technology, and other supporting information in the nomination package. Measures of the impact of the work include publications, presentations, patents, leadership & professional awards. The candidate's contributions should include independent work clearly distinguishable from their doctoral and post-doctoral work.

The nomination package must consist of the following items:

- 1) A nomination form (see next page).
- 2) A nomination letter of no more than 2 pages including a description of the nominee's contribution to the field of biochemical technology.
- 3) A resume of no more than 25 pages which includes the publication list of the nominee.
- 4) A maximum of three supporting letters, each no more than 2 pages, from individuals in the field. Letter writers should write for only one Young Investigator Award nominee in a given year.

Nomination packages are due by email (only) by the August 1 deadline to the address listed on the nomination form.

Selection:

The awardee is selected from among the nominees by a committee of prior awardees and senior BIOT members convened by the BIOT Division Awards Chair.
